The brevity of today's gospel reminds us that Mark is the shortest gospel. It's the shortest in-part because it was the first gospel written. The gospel we read today in Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John were preached verbally, immediately and continually since the moment of Pentecost, but because they thought Jesus' return was going to be extremely soon, they didn't see the need to write the gospel down. Although Mark was written about 65AD (Matthew 70AD, Luke 75AD, John 95AD), nothing changes the reality that Jesus can return at any moment. Even if it's not this week, still treat every moment like that last moment—because one day you'll be right!

Although Fr. Martin could only appreciate everyone's presence for liturgies, we must all remember that we are visiting God Himself. Therefore, men should always wear at least a collared shirt as well as slacks, and women should always wear either dresses or appropriate slacks and blouses.

This is not so-much because of modesty (important as that is), but because of **respect**. The consensus of Biblical scholars agree that the reason Saint Peter put on his outer garments in John 21:7 was to show **respect**, as he knew he was approaching God. Thank you for your consideration.

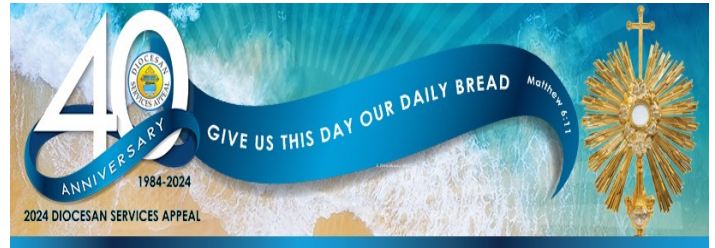

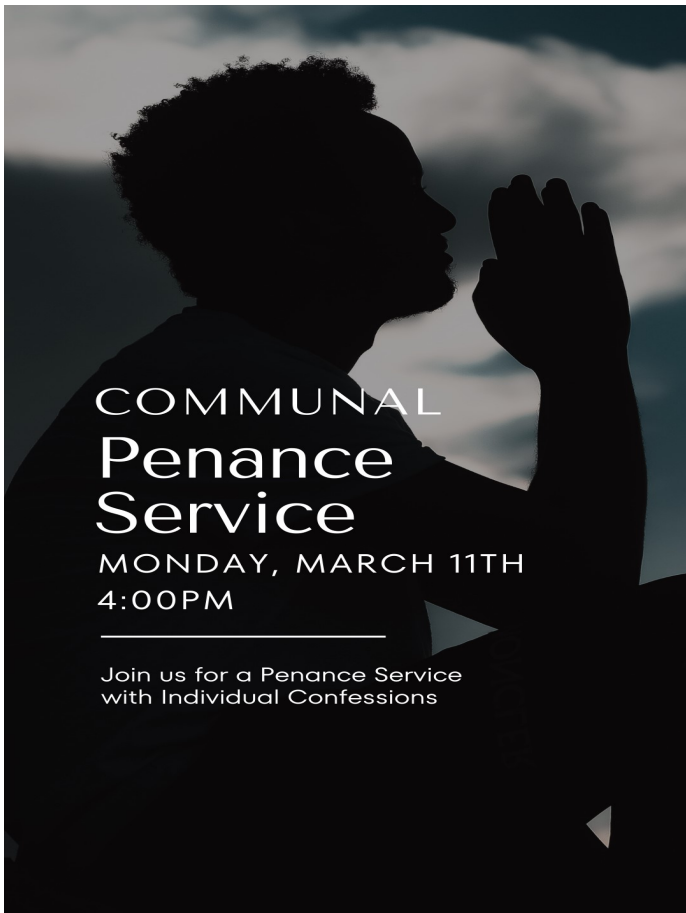
