Out of consideration to our fellow parishioners, and respect for those with mobility disabilities, please only park there if you have a physical need to do so. Thank you.

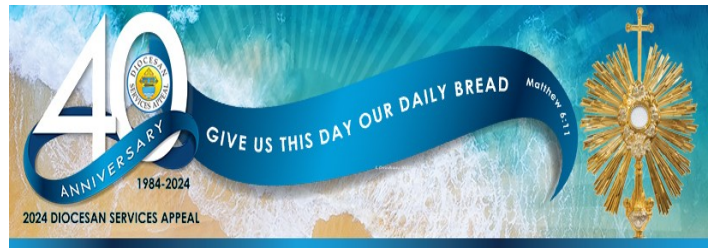

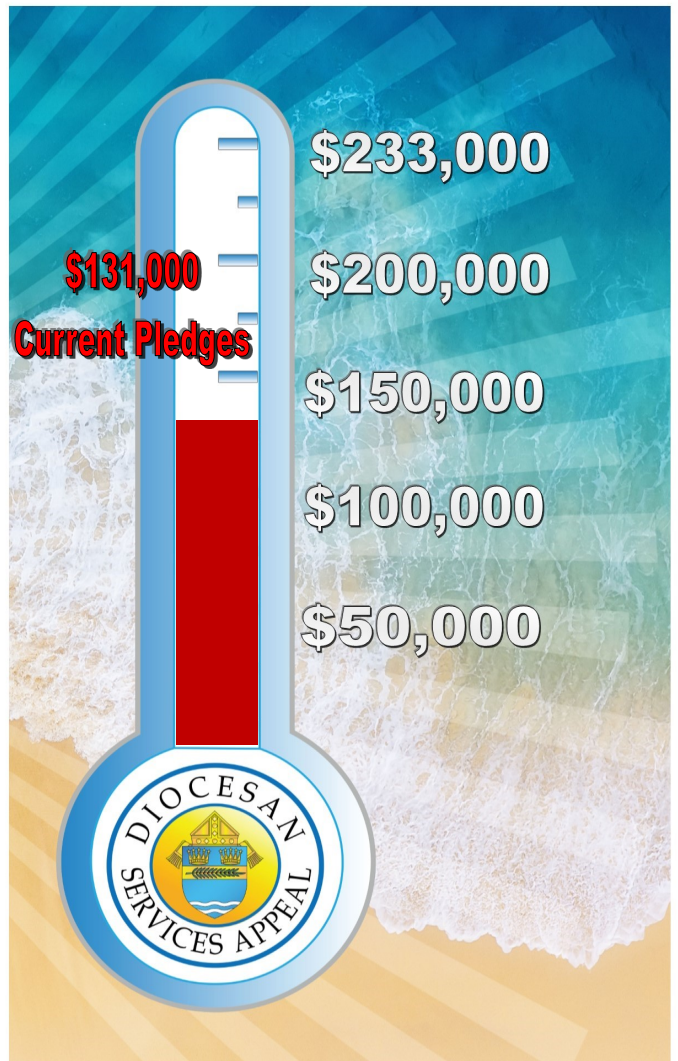
