
Reflections from Fr. Martin ~ 12th Sunday Ordinary Time ~ June 23rd, 2024

2024 Super Bowl Champion Harrison Butker delivered the commencement address at Benedictine College in Atchison, Kansas, on Saturday, May 11, 2024. He affirmed many eternal truths, yet I also feel compelled to clarify some things that I feel unintentionally caused confusion. Following the order of his speech, I will, periodically, over several weeks clarify some words (what I don't explicitly mention was technically not in contradiction with Church teachings).

<u>Transcript</u>: "Congress just passed a bill where stating something as basic as the biblical teaching of who killed Jesus could land you in jail."

<u>Clarification</u>: This bill, albeit hastily and sloppily written, condemned *using* the ugly <u>lie & myth</u> that the Jews killed Jesus as a license for anti-Semitic action. The Church has never said the Jews killed Jesus. More recently, Pope Benedict echoed in 2011 the fact there is no basis in Scripture for the belief that Jews were responsible for Jesus' death. Yes, some Roman & Jewish leaders conspired against Jesus. But when we say, each Sunday, in the Creed: "crucified under Pontius Pilate (who was <u>not</u> a Jew)", Church teaching holds that Pilate represents ALL of us; we ALL killed Jesus b/c of our sins; Jesus accepted His death to redeem us ALL.


